POSITION SUMMARY: Provides advocacy and support to individuals with substance use disorder (SUD) who are receiving services through Western Mental Health Center

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- 1. Performs all duties in accordance with the policies and procedures of the Center.
- 2. Provide individualized peer support to each client;
- 3. Promote a client's recovery goals, self-sufficiency, self-advocacy, and development of natural supports
- 4. Support a client's maintenance of skills that the client has learned from other services
- 5. Provides services to identified clients by providing clients outreach, crisis assistance, housing support, benefits assistance, vocational support, and life skills
- 6. Assists clients individually and in group settings to establish treatment/recovery plan.
- 7. Assumes management responsibilities for assigned cases. Serves as a productive member of a multidisciplinary team.
- 8. Coordinates assistance for clients with other community professionals; also serves as a resource, advocate, and liaison.
- 9. Completes required documentation of treatment planning and other required case file documentation.
- 10. Participates in all required SUD meetings. Provides and receives appropriate support and assistance with peer and/or supervision during consultation process
- 11. Available for evening and weekend work as required by Center needs.
- 12. Follow center billing procedures and requirements.

OTHER RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Is sensitive and responsive to management needs such as data collection and program evaluation.
- 3. Co-facilitate group counseling by planning and implementing chosen therapies with other SUD professionals assigned to the program, as necessary and/or required.
- 4. Ability to travel as required.
- 5. Performs other work related duties as assigned.
